Suspect Information: Property Crime Detective Kenjura is working with Wise County detectives on linking some suspects they arrested who had possession of stolen property from other crimes in this vicinity. Warrants are going to be issued for the actors who are still in custody, so we should see a reduction in BMVs.

Theft

Two minor thefts and 9 shopliftings were reported but are non-preventable by extra patrols. Most of these resulted in citations or arrests, or were known suspects.

Special Requests

I was emailed a request by Councilman Moon's aide regarding traffic issues at 7400 N Riverside Dr but NPO Moore has already been working on it. I addressed multiple calls/emails, some through the chain of command, about a registered sex-offender moving near Freedom Elementary School. I addressed concerns over an alleged attempted abduction that originally went unreported but was able to get them to make information report. Patrol officers reported an unoccupied homeless camp behind Walmart Supercenter which I followed up in getting cleaned up with Code Compliance. A community forum was requested and scheduled (Nov 10th) in the Wilshire Valley neighborhood due to above mentioned concerns as well as a 1-night BMV spree on unlocked vehicles (actors have already been charged by Property Crimes).
